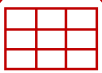

An easy-to-use and effective tool for quantifying individual and organisational exposure to risk from homeworking

SHARP helps NHS employees to self-assess their homeworking risks via an online survey. A personalised Risk Assessment Report is immediately generated at completion, identifying levels of risk, priority risk areas, information-handling vulnerabilities, well-being concerns and behavioural susceptibilities. A management dashboard aggregates data from responses informing NHS managers of the risk landscape from remote working. This understanding is key to strategic management of safety and security and future home or hybrid working plans.



1. Completion of the SHARP Survey Tool

The SHARP survey is a holistic homeworking self-assessment tool optimised for healthcare workers' use. Completion rarely exceeds 15 minutes and requires no prior preparation.



2. Employee access to their SHARP Report

Once the survey is complete, respondents may download their personnel risk assessment. This document quantifies and prioritises risk before guiding respondents on mitigative actions.



3. Line-management Information

An automated copy of a report may be sent to others e.g., Line Manager. This functionality ensures that NHS management are informed of individual employee needs and compliance.



4. The SHARP Data Dashboard

All data captured in completion of the SHARP survey is easily accessible to the organisation and conveniently presented through the SHARP Data Dashboard.



5. Strategic analysis and solutions
